HB 1292 Changes to Notary Public Requirements – Effective 1/1/2025

Georgia law is changing with the enactment of HB 1292, which will require the following modifications for Notary Publics, effective January 1, 2025:

Key Changes:

- Notary Publics shall complete GSCCCA Educational Training Class each term
- Criminal History / Background Checks Required for New Notary Publics & Reappointments
- Notary Publics to maintain a Journal of Notarial Acts

Training Course and Background Checks apply to new appointments and those seeking a reappointment

Upon completing and printing your Notary Application online, you will present the signed application to the Clerk's office and include the following:

- Training Certificate
 - Certificate of Completion of Notary Training Course from the Georgia Superior Court Cooperative Authority (GSCCCA). <u>This course must be completed within 30 days prior to you being appointed as a</u> Notary.

- Background Check / Criminal History
 - <u>The Background Check must have been completed within 30 days prior to submitting your Notary</u> <u>application to the Clerk's Office.</u>
 - Background checks may be obtained from the Eatonton Police Department, Monday Friday, from 8:00AM to 5:00PM, at a cost of \$30.00.

- Journal of Notarial Acts
 - A Notary Public shall maintain a written or electronic journal which shall include an entry for each notarial act performed.
